



New Your Chance Program

Our social impact programs have always existed to support the disadvantaged. We are excited to announce that we have launched an extension to our program focused on those disadvantaged who have a medically diagnosed disability, injury, or health condition.

It's called our **Your Chance** program and offers 12 months (or more) of employment, beginning as a part-time position and then growing at the participant's pace. Like our 2nd Chance Program, it is a value-based training program that includes regular sessions with our program coordinators, primarily focused on the participant

becoming 'job ready'. Our aim is that they graduate from the program into a full-time job placement of their choice with Joii or a host employer.



Joii Workstream

Joii Workstream has a busy office with more than 100 staff working for over 40 clients. We value our staff and plan a variety of pathways to connect them to both the Joii culture and their clients. This connection helps keep our turnover of staff very low, a fact that is loved by our clients.

Our team has gained a lot of experience in recruiting and assisting migrants for our social enterprises. These skilled migrants give us the capacity to build teams around them by employing local apprentices and trade assistants.

Our carpentry, bricklaying, and tiling teams are now growing through immigration and

the skills these new staff bring to our teams.





Staff have been arriving from the United Kingdom, South Africa, Europe, and the Philippines.

Word of our success has travelled the grapevine. Therefore, we took the opportunity to share our experience and are now assisting a range of businesses with immigration services. We help them by searching internationally for applicants and then applying for visas to fill positions such as welders, motor, diesel, and air conditioning, truck drivers and flooring installers.

Focus on Joii Roofing – Celebrating its Success.


Joii Trades are teams of dedicated people that produce competitively priced, high-

In this edition we are highlighting some of the great work undertaken by one of the key contributors to the success of Joii, it's our team of dedicated staff and subbies that work in our Social Enterprise called **Joii Roofing.**

Joii Roofing was established to help provide employment opportunities and affordable housing to the broader community. Joii Roofing is committed to providing a training and development pathway for the unemployed and those at risk.

Led by Stuart McGregor, Joii Roofing provides high-quality, affordable roofing solutions across South-East Queensland and Northern NSW.



Joii Roofing was also involved in a project to help Red Frogs store some of the 24 tonnes of Allen's frogs that they have distributed. Red Frogs provides a positive peer presence where young people gather, it educates them on safer partying behaviours and promotes and provides alcohol-free activities.

It was therefore a no-brainer for Joii Roofing to put its experience to work and build Red Frogs a storage and cooler area.

Tiny/Modular Home Project

Our tiny/modular home project is continuing to move forward. Over the past few

months, we've had meetings with two key areas of the State Government, Corrections and Housing and we plan to move the 'hope' we have for this of housing model into а life-transforming opportunity for the disadvantaged.

Our design provides dignified living in three separate spaces. It's based on two similar pods (one bed, bath & the other kitchen, dining) and are transported to the site fully completed and ready to live in within hours. The design includes a variety of off-the-grid options.





Our model links employment pathways to housing opportunities.

- 60% of those released return to prison within 2 years
- \$3 billion annually
- Community safety
- Employer stigma

- Safe work environment
- Positive peer environment & housing

- Learn character & skills that lead to positive employment outcomes.

2nd Chance Employment – Solving the Housing Shortage



SECOND CHANCE

When prisoners are released, they are provided with a subsidised commercial job and wrap around support.

The focus is on work related character traits & practical skills in a safe & controlled learning environment.

EMERGENCY HOUSING

The 2nd Chance jobs could become housing construction jobs and with innovating thinking, those requiring emergency housing such as DV victims, can be provided with fast comfortable living in

temporary housing in a range of locations depending on their needs.

DIGNIFIED LIVING

The housing crisis has increased homelessness. This means we need to think differently about how we support people needing a home.

By accessing underutilised land, portable homes can be provided either temporarily or longerterm with a dignified comfortable space to live

in.
