


Second Chance Program – Our Valued Partners



Joii is proud to have partnered with state & local government as well as employment agencies across the Ipswich and Logan areas to deliver our self-funded social impact programs that create employment & training opportunities where upon completion provides successful graduates with the necessary skills and experience to confidently re-enter the workforce and break free from the cycle of long-term welfare dependency and poverty.

We work closely with our partners to ensure the best possible outcome for our program participants. Whilst this isn't always possible (due to factors beyond our control), the success rate of the social enterprise model remains higher compared to the existing Disability Employment Services (DES) model as shown below.*

The Payment By Outcomes trial is the first of its kind in Australia. The Department of Social Services is partnering with White Box Enterprises and 16 social enterprises to measure the effectiveness of jobs-focused social enterprises in creating long-term meaningful employment for people who face barriers to work.


