

Tropical Cyclone Alfred - Impact on South-East QLD




Cyclone Alfred's Impact on South-East Queensland

Cyclone Alfred made landfall on Moreton Island on March 7, bringing with it destructive winds exceeding 100 km/h and torrential rainfall. Brisbane experienced approximately 260 mm of rain in a single day, resulting in flooding across low-lying suburbs. The cyclone's slow movement exacerbated its effects, leading to prolonged heavy rains and storm surges that caused significant coastal erosion, particularly on the Gold Coast. Power outages affected over 300,000 homes and businesses.

Joii Limited's Office Closure and Trade Suspension

In response to the severe weather conditions, Joii Limited proactively closed its offices on March 7, prioritising the safety of its staff and customers. The company communicated this decision through its social media channels, advising that staff would work remotely and that the office would reopen once it was deemed safe.





Wider Business Disruptions

Joii Limited was among several organisations that suspended operations due to Cyclone Alfred. Government service centers, including transport and motoring service centers, closed from March 6 until further notice. The closure of all Brisbane & regional council services, public roads, schools and transport including Brisbane Airport highlighted the vulnerability of the city's infrastructure to extreme weather events.

Cyclone Alfred's aftermath underscores the importance of preparedness and resilience in the face of increasingly frequent and severe weather events in the region.

Joii Trades - Queensland Building & Trades Sector Review - Q1 2025

The first quarter of 2025 has been a dynamic period for Queensland's building and trades sector, marked by significant infrastructure investments, regulatory reforms, and ongoing labour challenges.

Construction Activity & Approvals

Queensland's construction industry is experiencing robust growth, propelled by major infrastructure projects and preparations for the 2032 Olympics. However, this expansion is accompanied by concerns over cost overruns and project delays, primarily due to a shrinking workforce.

Building approvals have shown mixed trends. In February 2025, total dwelling approvals in Queensland decreased by 2.8% from January, totaling 2,968 units. Conversely, January saw a 6.3% increase in approvals, indicating short-term volatility. Over the three months to January, approvals were up 14.0% compared to the same period the previous year, with detached approvals up by 6.1% and multi-units up by 27.3%.



The sector continues to grapple with a significant labour shortage. Brisbane's construction industry faces a projected shortfall of over 25,000 skilled workers by 2025.

In the March quarter, technicians and trades workers constituted 14.4% of Queensland's workforce, reflecting the critical role of trades in the state's employment landscape.

To address these challenges, the Queensland Government has initiated the "Skilling Queenslanders for Work" program, aiming to develop a secure pipeline of skilled workers for high-demand industries like construction.

March Housing & Infrastructure Initiatives

In response to the housing crisis, the Queensland government launched the \$500 million Residential Activation Fund, targeting infrastructure projects that enable new housing developments. Half of the funding is allocated to South East Queensland, with local councils competing for support.

Regulatory Reforms & Industry Confidence

alleviate administrative burdens, the Queensland government has paused the requirement for self-employed tradies to complete annual financial paperwork or set up trust accounts for privately funded projects under \$10 million. This reform aims to expedite residential constructions and support over 50,000 builders and subcontractors in the state.

Queensland Sector Outlook


While the sector shows signs of recovery and growth, challenges persist. The projected labour shortfall and potential apartment supply shortages in Brisbane highlight the need for continued government intervention and strategic planning to sustain momentum and meet future demands.

Queensland Government is on the hunt for 50,000 construction workers to help build stadiums, roads and tackle the housing crisis. Tradies including carpenters, painters and electricians are among the most in-demand.
