Our Social Impact Programs

Joii's social impact programs are designed to empower individuals by providing training, employment opportunities, and support services.

Second Chance Program

The Second Chance Program is a transformative initiative aimed at providing hope and opportunity to individuals facing significant barriers to employment. By offering paid, real-world work experiences coupled with comprehensive training, the program equips participants with the skills and confidence needed to break free from the cycle of welfare dependence and poverty.

Key components of the program include:

Workplace Training: Participants engage in structured environments to learn technical skills and workplace expectations.

3C's Framework:

- Consistency: Developing reliable work habits and punctuality.
- **Communication**: Enhancing interpersonal skills and effective workplace dialogue.
- Compliance: Understanding and adhering to workplace policies and procedures.

Joii has committed a self-funded investment of \$5 million over five years into the Second Chance Program, projected to yield a \$47.7 million community benefit within this period.

Joii's integrated approach, combining social enterprise with targeted support programs, creates lasting change for individuals and communities.

By investing in people and fostering partnerships, Joii continues to build a more inclusive and equitable society.
